ST. ROSE OF LIMA SCHOOL

Who we are. . .

Founded by the late Msgr. John W. Struck, Saint Rose of Lima School opened its doors in 1966. In December 1996, we became the first Warwick school, public or private, to receive accreditation from the New England Association of Schools and Colleges (NEASC). Our school excels to this day because of the community of believers of Saints Rose and Clement Parish, who understand the important mission of Catholic education. Saint Rose of Lima School proudly reflects the Catholic values and traditions that form the backbone of our curriculum. Jesus Christ is the Chief Teacher in our school as we are faithful to the Roman Catholic Church in every way.

Our School Board serves as an advisory body to the pastor and principal and is composed of parents, parishioners and professional educators. School Board members are appointed by the pastor for five-year terms.

The Home and School Association (HSA) is an important partnership between the school and home in our cooperative venture of education. It helps in many ways by building school spirit and organizing fundraisers to keep the tuition at an affordable level. The officers (President/Vice President/Secretary and Treasurer) are elected for two-year terms.

In all that we do, Jesus is the reason for our school; therefore, all its policies and activities are carried out in accordance with Catholic teaching and tradition.

RELIGION PROGRAM

The teaching of the doctrines of the Catholic Faith, the development of Christian values, attendance at weekly Mass, and the reception of all Sacraments is of primary importance in this Catholic School. Each day begins and ends with prayer and grace is prayed before each meal.

Our second grade students are prepared for their First Penance and First Holy Communion during religion class and receive these Sacraments together. In addition to monthly and holy day Masses, there are prayer assemblies for the entire school during Advent and Lent. Stations of the Cross are prayed together on the Fridays of Lent and our eighth grade class celebrates "Living Stations" for the local community.

The Rosary is prayed daily during the months of October and May and an outdoor May Procession is held each year.

S.T.E.A.M. CURRICULUM

S.T.E.A.M. (Science, Technology, Engineering, The Arts and Mathematics) courses are a core part of our academic program. Students in grades seven and eight are grouped by ability so that they have the opportunity to take Pre-Algebra and Algebra I in preparation for high school. Science and Engineering are strongly promoted through a hands-on curriculum, and current Technology is used throughout the day. Art, Music and Drama programs are offered to enrich the lives of our students.

MIDDLE SCHOOL



Our middle school offers a departmental setting with excellent preparation for both Catholic and public high schools. Students participate in the National History Day and Science Olympiad competitions. Our students regularly place in honors courses at the high school of their choice.
