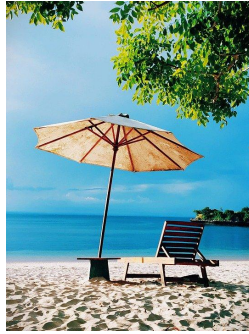

### **6th Grade Summer Reading**

#### **Required Reading**

- Read a FICTION book of your choice that is within your ZPD. Have fun and select a book that looks enjoyable to you. A great place to search for summer reading is at the public library. Lists are available by grade at the library and the main branch on Sandy Lane in Warwick also has a special section for middle school summer reading. After reading, complete an AR quiz and create a “Book Talk” presentation. Directions are attached. Book Talk presentations will take place during the first week or two of school. This is a great opportunity to hear what your friends read over the summer and to give you some ideas for your next independent reading book.
- Read a NONFICTION book of your choice that is within your ZPD. Students typically love the Who Was/What Was Series although you may select any nonfiction book that interests you. Please be sure that you are selecting a book that you have not read yet. You must complete an AR quiz on this book as well as write a one paragraph summary. The summary and AR quiz must be completed during the first week of school.
