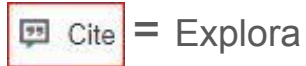
It's Simple!

1) Search Topic & Choose/Open link to the Source (article, image, e-book)

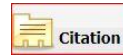
2) Locate & click citation icon for that source. Examples:
